Illinois EPA performed several audits of municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) programs this year

Each audit included a visit to one of the community's maintenance yards, with focus on:

- Salt storage
- Material storage areas
- Vehicle washing areas

Salt Storage

Salt contained within a permanent structure

Excess salt in a structure or temporary tarp









Material Storage Areas

Effective containment

Protection from stormwater

Staining from storage area to storm drain inlet







Vehicle Washing Areas

Indoor wash racks, triple basin to sanitary

Exterior wash areas, designated and well kept

Protected from storm drain inlets
